CALL TO ORDER

Supervisor Holland looked for a motion to approve the minutes of the Board of Supervisors Solid Waste Committee Meeting on Wednesday, November 13, 2024. No changes or additions were suggested. 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STAFF / COMMITTEE REPORTS

a. GVCC Tire Collection Event - March 1, 2025

Amy Welch gave a report on a FREE upcoming community event for Tuolumne County residents. On Saturday, March 1, 2025, between 8:00 AM – 12:00 PM, the Tuolumne County Solid Waste Division and the Greater Valley Conservation Corps will be hosting a tire recycling event for Tuolumne County Residents. The event will be held in East Sonora at the Greater Valley Conservation Corps satellite offices located at 14993 Camage Avenue. Residents are permitted to recycle up to nine car or passenger truck tires. Tires must be off the rims. No tractor-trailer or tractor tires are accepted. No commercial or business tires. b. Report Out – Cal Sierra Transfer Station Fire

Deborah Reagan reported that both Waste Management representatives who regularly attend the monthly BOSSWC were unable to attend this meeting. The Solid Waste Division has received the Cal-Fire report from the fire that ignited early in the morning on Sunday, August 11, 2024, in a building at the Cal Sierra Waste Management Transfer Station at 19309 Industrial Drive in Sonora. The monitoring system at the Transfer Station showed a water pressure drop from the sprinklers but failed to alert the proper authorities. The sprinkler system was successful in containing the fire until the fire department was notified by a concerned neighbor who placed the initial call regarding the fire. There were multiple points of failure that caused concern and emergency contacts had not been properly updated resulting in a failure of notification to the Waste Management operations personnel and the Solid Waste Director.

c. Green Waste Community Collection Program

Deborah Reagan gave an update on the green waste community collection program. Cal Recycle amended and gave the County budget approval to purchase a chipper that will be delivered to the Sheriff's Department on Tuesday, February 18th. A 14-foot dump trailer was purchased and is expected to be delivered Wednesday, February 12th. The Solid Waste Division has also funded large 48-gallon reuseable home and yard bags that hold up to 1,000 pounds each. Fire Wise Communities are the focus for the program, and 100 tons of the County's annual 1,000-ton disposal allowance has been allocated for green waste programs. This program is eligible to County and City as it was a regional grant application. Leaves, pine needles, and small brush will be transported to the Earth Resource Facility. Solid Waste is researching options to send the wood chips to a local biomass facility. Supervisor Kirk requested talking points to announce the program and its successes, inform the public, and encourage Firewise community support.
