CALL TO ORDER

Supervisor Holland called the meeting of Wednesday, October 8, 2025, to order at 1:00 P.M.

Seeing no one else wishing to speak, Supervisor Holland closed the public forum.

COMMITTEE BUSINESS

A. Consideration of approving the minutes of the meeting on Wednesday, September 10, 2025.

Supervisor Holland looked for a motion to approve the minutes of the Board of Supervisors Solid Waste Committee Meeting on Wednesday, September 10, 2025. A minor change and addition was requested by Committee Member Griffin noting that City of Sonora residents will still be able to bring trash to the Cal Sierra Transfer Station. A motion was made by Committee Member Griffin and a second by Committee Member La Torre, motion passes 3-0.

STAFF / COMMITTEE REPORTS

A. 10/11 Green Waste Dollar Dump Day Event

Debbie Reagan gave a report on an upcoming green waste event for Tuolumne County residents. On Saturday, October 11, 2025, between the hours of 8:00 A.M. and 11:45 A.M. and 12:30 P.M. and 3:30 P.M., the Tuolumne County Solid Waste Division, in co-operation with Cal Sierra Disposal will be hosting the last quarterly Green Waste Dollar Day event for the year. This event will give residents an opportunity to clear their property of hazardous vegetation, up to one (1) cubic yard, and dispose of it at a significantly reduced disposal rate of \$1.00 a cubic yard (3x3x3). Any waste over one (1) cubic yard will be charged the regular rate for disposal.

B. Upcoming Firewise Events

Debbie Reagan provided an update to the committee on two upcoming Firewise community events. Scenic Brook will hold a community event on Saturday, October 18, 2025, and the Greenley Oaks community has an event scheduled for Saturday, November 8, 2025.

C. America Recycles Day – November 15, 2025

On Saturday, November 15, 2025, from 10:00 A.M. – 2:00 P.M., Tuolumne County Public Works Department, Solid Waste Division will be hosting a free drive-thru recycling event at the Motherlode Fairgrounds located at 220 Southgate Drive in Sonora. This will be a one-stop recycling event where you will be able to recycle a wide variety of items including mattresses and box springs, tires, cardboard, scrap metal, eyeglasses, e-waste, magazine and newspaper, household hazardous waste, textiles, mixed recycling, mercury thermometers, batteries, light bulbs, and paper shredding. No household trash will be accepted. This event is for Tuolumne County residents only, no businesses allowed.

D. Dump Coupon Update

Debbie Reagan provided an update on the "Keep Tuolumne Clean" Coupons that the Solid Waste Division has been giving out since the April Home and Garden Show for all Tuolumne County residents. The coupons were set to expire September 30, 2025, but have been extended to December 31, 2025. Coupons will be available at our office in the A.N. Francisco Building located at 48 Yaney Avenue in Sonora from 8:00 A.M. – 4:00 P.M. Monday - Friday.

DISCUSSION / ACTION ITEMS

A. City of Sonora collection services change – County impacts

Debbie Reagan confirmed that County Facilities within Sonora City limits will still be serviced under the existing franchise agreement with Cal Sierra/WM.

The longer-term impact comes with the Cal Sierra Transfer Station no longer receiving integrated waste management fees from the City's materials. The County would like to see the Transfer Station keeping track of who comes in and out through City and County zip codes specifically for self-haul.

City residents will still be allowed to haul to the transfer station and access the County's monthly household hazardous waste disposal events.

Cal Waste plans to begin service the week of November 3, 2025, and will have a local office on Stockton Road in Downtown Sonora. Cal Waste will be removing existing Cal Sierra Disposal bins and replacing them in the coming weeks.
