Are you having trouble with your Libby app? The library's catalog system and Libby received an upgrade in January; because of this Libby now wants everyone to verify

their pin. When you applied for a library card, the library assigned you a pin, the default being the last 4 digits of your phone number. If you've forgotten your pin, you can call the Sonora Main Library at (209) 533-5507 or your closest branch and we can confirm it for you. You may have to enter the pin more than once before Libby lets you back in. Did you know you can also use your pin to access your library account? When accessing the library's home page, click the Library Catalog link on the left-hand side to open the library catalog. In the brown bar on top the page select either "log in" or "my account". The pop-up window will ask you for your library card number and pin. Logging into the system provides the ability to see what you have checked out, when your items are due, renew your items once if they aren't already late or requested by another patron, and request new items to be held for you.

### **Twain Harte Branch**




