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**HWY 120 Detour Maintenance Repairs (Jacksonville Road Chipseal)**

Description

The proposed project will maintain the existing road by use of a rubberized asphalt chipseal Jacksonville Road (Hwy 120 to Stent Road), Algerine Road (Stent Road to Campo Seco), Campo Seco (Algerine Road to Seco Street), and Seco Street (Campo Seco to Main Street). The project is partially funded by the CalRecycle Rubberized Pavement Grant Program and will divert approximately 7,000 California waste tires from the waste stream.

Preventative maintenance and repair damages caused by Caltrans Highway 120 detour route.
