PROJECT INFORMATION UPDATE

The Federal Highway Administration, Central Federal Lands Highway Division (FHWA-CFLHD), in cooperation with Forest Service—Stanislaus National Forest (STF) and Tuolumne County, is improving a portion of Buchanan Road. Road improvements start at Carter Street and end at Fish Hatchery Road. Replacement of the Buchanan Mine Road Bridge is also included in this project.

Construction will be in two segments; one from Carter Street to Canyon Drive and the second from Canyon Drive to Fish Hatchery Road and the Buchanan Mine Road Bridge. Currently work is only from Canyon Drive to Fish Hatchery Road

Ongoing construction operations began on Monday, October 23, 2017 with an expected completion date of September 28, 2018.

- Between Canyon Drive and Fish Hatchery Road expect single-lane closures with alternate one-way traffic control and 30 minute delays between 6:00 AM and 7:00 PM Monday through Saturday.
- Outside of normal work hours expect temporary traffic control with single lane closures with either STOP/Proceed When Clear signs or Temporary Traffic Signals.
- Blasting on Buchanan Road may require intermittent closures on the West Side Trail for up to 30 minutes.

Work is weather permitting and subject to change.
