Please Note

Attendance to all classes is mandatory for all Resource Family applicants to become approved AND begin accepting children into the home. If you have a relative/non-related child or youth placed in your home through an emergency placement agreement, you must also take all courses to finalize the approval process.

PRE-SERVICE Training is a process designed to strengthen competencies required for a successful fostering, caregiving, and/or adopting experience. Participants will gain a basic understanding of the emotional, social, psychological, behavioral, and cognitive issues regarding children who have been abused or neglected and will learn appropriate discipline techniques. Each module is three hours. ***Participants must complete all four modules in order to satisfy the pre-service training requirements of being an approved caregiver.***
