CCW INITIAL APPLICANT PROCEDURE

Introduction

This information sheet is for persons desiring to obtain a permit to carry a concealed pistol, revolver or other firearm. The issuance of a Concealed Weapons Permit is governed by California Penal Code Section 12050.

Concealed Weapons Permit

The Sheriff may issue a Concealed Weapons Permit under the following Conditions:

- The Applicant is a resident of the County
- The Applicant is of good moral character
- The Applicant has good cause for carrying a concealed weapon

Departmental Restrictions on Issuance of a Permit

- Residence in the County for less than 1 year (There are some exceptions for employment in the County)
- Subject of a Restraining Order issued by any Court
- Conviction of driving under the influence of drugs/alcohol within the past 5 years
- Conviction of a felony
- Conviction of a misdemeanor offence which renders one unlawful to possess a firearm under Penal Code Section 12021
- Conviction of a drug offense under the Health and Safety Code within the past 5 years
- Other cause to question residency, insufficient cause for carry a concealed weapon, or suitability of carrying a concealed weapon.

Procedure for Obtaining a Concealed Weapons Permit

All applications for Carrying Concealed Weapon permits are now submitted and processed through Permitium at the following web address:

- Make sure to choose the INITIAL application and not the Renewal application (Different fees apply, and you will have to restart your application). Initial fees are \$131.39 and must be paid by credit card on Permitium
- Up to 3 firearms are allowed – You must add every firearm into the application that you want to have on the permit. All firearms must be registered to you and at your current address - the only exception is if married you may put your spouse's firearm on your permit.

- If your firearms are registered to you or your spouse but not at your current address, you will need to update your firearms registration with the Department of Justice. You can update your information by creating a CFARS account at the following web address:

- You must provide the following documentation when applying on Permitium:
 - **Proof of residency:** Vehicle registration, insurance, property tax receipts, cellphone bill are not proof, it must be a utility bill associated with your residence, ex: electric, rental lease or agreement, cable, Internet, gas, water, or garbage
 - **California Driver's License** with current address
 - **Live fire certificate** of attending training course. You must have an 8-hour course certificate that shows live fire proficiency for all firearms on your permit (Per AB 2103)
- Your permit will not be issued until we have received all requested documentation.

******After applying on Permitium: Call 209-533-5833 to make an appointment for an initial interview******

- If approved after interview, you will be sent to get a livescan (all CCW applicants must be livescanned regardless of any previous livescans). Fingerprint returns are sent to our agency for review from DOJ. Based on the findings from the DOJ report, the Sheriff's Office, will determine the final eligibility of the applicant.
- If/when approved, you will receive an email regarding the change in status and you will pay the second initial fee online
 - Second initial fee is \$125.43, this payment is also made on Permitium
- Your permit will be ready for pick-up after the second and final payment has been made. You may call to make an appointment to pick up the permit. Office hours are M-F 8am to 3:45pm for permits to be picked up. Bring your driver's license for identification when picking up.

To upload any requested documentation, you will log in using your Order Number, Email Address, and Password at the following web address:

Keep your CCW Order number and remember your password as you will need them to access your application for the second payment to to upload requested documentation.

If computer assistance is needed, you can go to the Sonora CSU on Wednesdays between 10am and 4pm, please call beforehand for an appointment at 209-536-9828. There will be a volunteer there to answer questions and give you access to a computer and scanner.
