NEW IN-HOME SUPPORTIVE SERVICES (IHSS) PROVIDERS Applicant Information

In 2009, changes were made to State law regarding IHSS providers. It requires providers attend orientation, and complete a criminal background check in order to receive payment from the IHSS Program. Providers will not be paid for providing IHSS services until the forms, orientation, and background check are completed.

ORIENTATION:

- All forms will be provided, and completed at orientation.
- Located at the **Public Health Department, Central Conference Room, located at 20111 Cedar Road N., Sonora.**
- **Please bring a valid photo ID, and your social security card.**

LIVE SCAN FINGERPRINTING INFORMATION:

- This form is needed in order to complete your criminal background check will be given to you when you attend orientation.
- This background check will verify any criminal history to determine if you have a conviction for child abuse, elder abuse, or Medi-Cal fraud within the last ten years. A conviction within the last 10 years will make you ineligible to receive payment from the IHSS Program.
- As an IHSS Provider, you will be responsible for the costs of the background check.
- Following the completion of your background check, you may be eligible to receive retroactive back pay from your original application date, for services you have provided.

2021 ORIENTATION DATES AND TIMES:

- Orientation is held on the second Tuesday of each month, from 9:00 am until 12:00 pm. You must arrive on time. **Late arrivals will not be allowed entry.**
