
## What Is the Law?

Since 1987 it has been illegal to dispose of used oil in sewers, in storm drains, in water, and on the ground. It is also illegal to burn used oil in your home or yard, or to throw it in the trash.

## The Hazards of Used Oil

Used oil can contain such contaminants as lead, magnesium, copper, zinc, chromium, arsenic, chlorides, cadmium, and chlorinated compounds. Oil poured down drains or onto the ground can work its way into our ground and surface waters and cause pollution. Keep our county clean! Recycle used motor oil and oil filters!



# Can Used Oil Be Recycled?

Yes, and oil filters too! Used oil can be re-refined into new motor oil or other lubricating oils. Filters will be drained, crushed and recycled into rebar.

# RECYCLE Used Motor Oil and Oil Filters



# Used motor oils that can be recycled include:

Engine lubricating oils
Gearbox and differential oils
Transmission fluids
Vehicle crankcase oils

- Drain used oil into a clean, leak proof container and do not overfill.
- Place used oil filters in a used oil filter collection container or in a sealable plastic bag.
- Do not mix any other materials, including water, with used oil.
- Take your used oil to a used oil collection site.

## **Certified Collection Centers**

- Accept used motor oil during normal business hours
- Most locations accept used oil filters \*
- Keep container size to 5 gallons or less
- Upon request by customer:
   Center must pay \$0.40 / gallon (\$)
   Payment may be cash, store credit or coupon
- Auto Service businesses are required to ask for a customer's name, address, and phone number, when paying customers for oil
