Re: Billing for services to non-transported patients

The purpose of this memo is to clarify the ability of Tuolumne County Ambulance Service to bill for services when a patient is treated and not transported. Tuolumne County Ambulance Service is authorized to charge non-transported emergency patients the following:

Procedure	March 1, 2021	July 1, 2021
EKG	\$179.00	\$224.00
Treat, non-transport	\$437.00	\$547.00

A treated and non-transported patient is defined as a patient that receives one or more ALS medication(s) or procedure(s).

If non-transported patients does not meet the condition(s) above, no bill for services may be assessed.
