SUMMERVILLE UNION HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT BOND MEASURE TO BE VOTED ON AND NOTICE FIXING TIME FOR SUBMISSION OF DIRECT ARGUMENTS FOR AND AGAINST MEASURE AND REBUTTAL ARGUMENTS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a General Election will be held in the County of Tuolumne, State of California, on Tuesday, November 5, 2024, at which election the following measure is to be voted on within the Summerville Union High School District of the County of Tuolumne:

MEASURE “B”: “To improve the quality of local high schools; make health, safety, and security improvements; modernize/construct classrooms, restrooms, school, and sports facilities; improve technology infrastructure; and replace aging portables with permanent classrooms; shall Summerville Union High School District’s measure authorizing \$13,000,000 of bonds at legal rates be adopted, generating approximately \$753,000 annually, while bonds are outstanding, at average rates of \$17 per \$100,000 assessed value, with annual audits, citizens’ oversight, NO money for salaries and all money staying local?”

The final date for submission is hereby fixed as September 2, 2024.

NOTICE IS ALSO HEREBY GIVEN that the polls will be open from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. on the 5th day of November 2024. Ballots will be counted at Election Central, after the polls close, at 2 South Green Street, Sonora, CA 95370.
