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Tuolumne County Public Health Confirms Two Cases of Measles

Tuolumne County, CA – The Tuolumne County Public Health Department (TCPH) has confirmed that the suspected cases of two Tuolumne County residents [reported on March 18, 2025](#), are positive for measles. The cases are an adult and a child under the age of 18 from the same household who had recently traveled internationally. Vaccination status for both cases is unconfirmed at this time.

Public Health is actively working to identify and contact those who may have been exposed. “We understand that there may be a lot of questions and concerns. The investigation is still ongoing, and we will provide updates as they are available. We want to remind the public that measles is a highly contagious disease and to take steps to protect yourself and your family by ensuring current vaccination status for measles, monitoring for symptoms, and staying home when you feel sick,” states Michelle Jachetta, Tuolumne County Public Health Director.
