#### **Volunteer to Tutor**

#### **Tutor Requirements:**

- Be at least 18 years of age or older and complete the volunteer application materials.
- Complete a brief interview and information overview with Literacy Staff.
- Be willing to dedicate at least one hour a week to tutoring one-on-one or leading a class/group.
- Be able to commit to tutoring for a minimum of six months.
- Complete simple monthly tutor reports to help document learners progress.
