COED Competitive Slow Pitch "A" and "B" Divisions

- Competitive COED will play without Commitment Lines and Safety Run Through Lines. There will be no automatic force outs and you cannot over run bases (except 1st). Sliding is allowed.
- Team Managers are responsible for having all players read and accept the online Participation Liability Waiver and all players on the roster are fully "Verified".
- A "Verified" player is one who has completed online registration and agreed to the Participation Liability Waiver.
- Rosters must have a minimum of ten (10) "Verified" players with a maximum of eighteen (18) "Verified" players.
- Player Adds are accepted online after the first game and will require a Player Add Fee which is due and payable at the time of the add. Players who are added to the roster after the first league game, who have not completed the Player Add process and paid the Player Add fee, are considered illegal players. Games illegal players participate in will be forfeited.
- Coed Competitive "A" Division does not have any Upper Division Player restrictions Coed Competitive "B" leagues may have up to 4 Upper Division players (2 male/2 Female).
- Teams may use four (4) "Borrowed Players" (BP's), two (2) male and two (2) female per game. BP's must bat in the last available spot in the batting order based on gender. A female BP must be the last female player to hit in the line-up and a male BP must be the last male to hit in the line-up.
- BP's may only fill-in for a team three (3) times during the season. BP's must be rostered players from the same league night only. BPs are not allowed in the playoffs except in serious or compelling circumstances.
- <u>Players are eligible to participate on multiple teams in different divisions per night during the season</u>. However, Players may only play for one (1) Team per night in the playoffs. Player must be a "Verified" rostered player for each team. Player must play minimum # of league games for a team to qualify for the team's playoff roster.
- A team will forfeit a game when it fails to have the minimum number of eight (8) players. A team will also forfeit a game if an "Unverified" player is used, a "BP" is used more than three (3) times, an illegal player is used and/or a player is listed on the roster under an assumed name.
- A batted "line-drive" or a "single bounce chopped ball" that goes up the middle of the diamond, between the Pitchers Safety Lines (chalked lines adjacent to pitching rubber) will result in a dead ball out.
- "One Up" home run rule applies to this League. Subsequent over the fence home runs count as singles and the runners may only advance one (1) base.
- Time limit is seven (7) innings or sixty-five (65) minutes with the exception of "The Championship" game.
- No new inning may be started if less than five (5) minutes remain in the game.
- The USA Softball "Mercy Rule" will be in effect for all League games including playoffs: 20 runs after three (3) innings, 15 runs after four (4) innings and 10 runs after five (5) innings.
- Playoff seeding will be determined by winning percentage.
- Only bats which bear the USA Softball approved certification mark, or those listed on the list published by USA Softball National Office are allowed.
- The Men's Balls utilized in COED softball will have a safety core.
