I. AUTHORITY

Division 2.5, California Health and Safety Code, Section 1797.220.

II. PURPOSE

The purpose of this policy is to define the standard EMS response to requests for service at the Black Oak Casino and the transition of patient care.

III. POLICY

- A. The standard EMS response to requests for medical assistance at the Black Oak Casino shall be one (1) ALS ambulance and one (1) first response provider unit.
- B. Tuolumne County Medical Dispatch is authorized to dispatch additional first responder or ambulance resources as may be required for the situation (i.e. multi-casualty incidents.)
- C. Based on the need for heightened security, EMS personnel are prohibited from responding to EMS requests at the Black Oak Casino in private automobiles.
- D. Black Oak Casino shall have certified EMT safety personnel on-duty on a continual 24-hour a day basis.

IV. PROCEDURE

- A. Black Oak Casino safety personnel shall respond to reported medical emergencies within the casino and determine the need for an EMS response.
- B. Black Oak Casino shall request an EMS response by contacting 9-1-1.
- C. Ambulance and First Response units shall access the casino through the emergency services entrance. Black Oak Casino safety personnel will escort EMS personnel to the patient.
