Buchanan Road

From Carter Street to Fish Hatchery Road/Buchanan Mine Road Bridge PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Federal Highway Administration, Central Federal Lands Highway Division (FHWA-CFLHD), in cooperation with Forest Service—Stanislaus National Forest (STF) and Tuolumne County, is improving a portion of Buchanan Road. The improvements include (1) rehabilitation of 0.6 mile of Buchanan Road beginning in Tuolumne at Carter Street; (2) reconstruction of 1.9 miles of Buchanan Road from Tuolumne to the Buchanan Mine Road (BMR) Bridge; and (3) removal and replacement of the BMR Bridge to the south of the existing bridge across the North Fork Tuolumne River.

PURPOSE: The purpose of the proposed action is to improve the operation and safety of the roadway and reduce maintenance cost.

ONGOING CONSTRUCTION OPERATIONS: For October 23, 2017 to November 30, 2017 work will be beginning on excavation between Canyon

Drive and Fish Hatchery Road and on foundations for the new BMR Bridge.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS: For October 23, 2017 to November 3, 2017, normal work hours will be Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. with intermittent traffic closures consisting of 30 min delays.

Beginning November 6, 2017 normal work hours will be Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. but Motorists can expect to find the **ROAD CLOSED** during the hours of 8 a.m. to 5p.m. Traffic will be allowed to pass through the entire project between 12:00 p.m. and 12:30 p.m. No night or weekend work is currently scheduled. Work is weather permitting.
